In some cases many minor and surface repairs can be done without fully draining the pool by using partial drainage or no drain techniques.

MYTH 03 POOL REPAIRS ARE JUST A TEMPORARY FIX.

DEBUNKED

When done properly by professionals, most common pool repairs like replastering, tiling and crack repairs provide long-lasting

MYTH 04 YOU HAVE TO REPLACE THE ENTIRE POOL SHELL WHEN REPAIRING MAJOR CRACKS.

Advanced repair methods like localized demolition, additional rebar and hydraulic cement can permanently fix even large cracks without requiring full pool demolition.

MYTH 05 ANY HANDYMAN CAN DO SIMPLE POOL REPAIRS.

Even basic repairs should be done by certified pool repair professionals who understand proper techniques and safety requirements.

Locating leaks often requires specialized equipment and experience, as the source can be hard to pinpoint visually.

5 SIGNS YOUR POOL NEEDS TO BE REPLASTERED ———

Over time, pool plaster can deteriorate, affecting both the appearance and functionality of your pool. Here are 5 common indicators that it's time to consider replastering:

- Your pool surface feels rough or has visible pitting, creating an uncomfortable texture when touched.
- You notice discoloration or stains that persist despite proper
 chemical balance and cleaning efforts.
- The plaster is flaking off or "spalling," leaving small chunks or dust at the bottom of the pool.
- There are visible cracks in the pool surface, which can lead to water loss and further damage if left unaddressed.
- Your pool requires increasingly frequent acid washing to maintain its appearance, indicating worn-out plaster.

Ignoring the Pool's Age and Overall Condition

When planning repairs or renovations, it's a mistake to focus solely on specific issues without considering the pool's overall age and condition. This oversight can result in piecemeal repairs that don't address systemic problems, potentially leading to more extensive and costly renovations in the near future.



Disregarding Professional Expertise

While some pool repairs may seem straightforward, many issues require specialized knowledge and experience. Attempting complex repairs or renovations without consulting professionals can exacerbate problems and compromise the pool's integrity.







Cutting Corners on Materials

It's essential to gauge the specialist's qualifications, certifications, and years of hands-on experience in the specific services you require.

♦ How do you ensure customer satisfaction and maintain transparency throughout the pool building process?

A reliable pool builder should provide an honest and transparent experience from start to finish. Ask about: Client reviews, line-item proposals, and how they exceed customers expectations.

Can you provide a detailed scope of work and project timeline?

Request a comprehensive breakdown of the proposed repairs, materials needed, and a realistic timeline for completion, factoring in potential delays or contingencies.

What warranties or guarantees do you offer on your work?

Reputable specialists should stand behind their workmanship and materials, offering warranties or guarantees to protect your investment.

Can you provide references or examples of similar projects?

Ask for references from previous clients who have undergone similar leak detection, repair, or renovation projects, and request to see before-and-after photos or examples of their work.

PREPARING FOR YOUR FACE-TO-FACE MEETING

To ensure a productive meeting, here are several things you can do to prepare for your pool renovation consultation:

Include All Decision-Makers:

If multiple household members will be involved in the decision-making process, ensure everyone is present during the consultation.

Allocate Sufficient Time:

Pool renovation discussions can be detailed, so set aside at least an hour (or more) for the meeting.

Gather Inspiration Materials:

Compile a folder or digital board with images, ideas, and inspiration for your desired pool renovation. This will help the contractor understand your vision.

Provide Property Information:

Have your property survey handy, as it can address questions about easements or other potential issues. If your neighborhood has a Homeowners Association, provide their details as well.



Discuss Budget and Financing:

If you have a specific budget in mind or have been pre-approved for a loan, communicate this to the contractor upfront. This will help them explore options that align with your financial parameters.

Determine Meeting Goals:

Decide whether you're prepared to make a decision during the consultation or if you need more time to consider your options. If you might sign a contract that day, be ready to thoroughly review it and understand the scope of work, inclusions, and exclusions.

Consider Payment Options:

Determine if you're prepared to make a down payment or finance the project during the consultation, and discuss the available options with the contractor.
